Clarification of News Report

This refers to your request for clarification of the news article entitled "Billionaire, others sued for tax evasion" posted in BusinessWorld Online on April 14, 2015. The article reported in part that:

"THE HEAD of another listed company led the latest batch of those sued by government for alleged tax evasion.

The Bureau of Internal Revenue (BIR) has sued Joseph H. Calata -- chairman, president and chief executive officer of agribusiness-focused Calata Corp. whom the agency described in a statement yesterday as a 'self-made billionaire' -- for allegedly defrauding the government of P144.49 million in income tax, including surcharge and interest, for 2011 alone.

Sought for comment, Mr. Calata denied he was a tax evader.

'I'm not guilty, hindi po ako nagnanakaw sa gobyerno (I don't steal from the government),' he said in a text message.

'I don't evade taxes. I pay what is required of me. What I know is that I try to create jobs and develop agriculture,' he added.

'I'm optimistic that justice will be done to me through the judicial process. In the meantime, a man is innocent until proven guilty.'
